

QIPs approved during the year 2014-15

SI No	Focus area of Intervention	Municipality and Sector	Description of project
1	Capacity building	Bint Jubayl, SW	The project aimed at building agricultural capacities of 300 olive farmers by giving them workshops on good olive practices. The project also equipped three agricultural cooperatives with equipment needed to test olive oil quality.
2	Power	Al Qantarah, SE	This project provided new cables for the generator network, to improve electric power supply to households, which will in turn help to improve delivery of electric power to villages.
3	Roads	El Fraidiss, SE	The project entailed construction of approximately 2100 m2 of agricultural roads. It involved repairs and reconstruction of an agriculture road connecting the villages of El-Fraidiss and Rachaya Al Foukhar. The project assumes importance because 95% of the population depends on agriculture for their sustenance.
4	Power	Hebbariye, SE	The project sought to facilitate better access to basic services by providing a generator to support one of the current generators in the municipality.
5	Social Infrastructure	Houla, SE	The project rehabilitated the municipality building, which was in very bad condition. The building of the Municipality was earlier a public school that has never seen any renovation.
6	Education	El Adeisse, SE	The project supported the provision of equipment, educational materials and furniture for classrooms, administrative office and the kitchen as well as external curtains in the new branch of the school with special needs in El Adaisse. This is expected to benefit around 300 children with special needs in the whole caza of Marjayoun.
7	Capacity building	Arkoub, SE	The project supported the conduct of 6 vocational training courses on handicrafts, jewelry making, hair dressing, pottery decoration etc. Women who underwent the training will be able to sell their products or use the newly developed skills to better their socio-economic situation and support their families.
8	Roads	Kafer Chouba, SE	This project rehabilitated an agricultural Road (approximately 820 sq. meters of road) that connects Kafer Chouba, LAF CP and UNP 4-31.
9	Capacity building	Tyre, SW	This project bolstered the capacity of a local association by providing it with sounds and light equipment which will improve the theatre, cinema and arts workshops that are organized inside Hamra Theater in Tyre by the association targeting Lebanese southern youth. This project supported the development of artistic capacities among youth/children by enabling the conduct of trainings/workshops.
10	Education	Bayt Lif, SW	This project equipped KG classes of the Public school with educational materials and equipment and also rehabilitated the playground for use by children.
11	Education	Barish, SW	This project provided computers and audio - visual equipment for a Public library.

12	Water	Dayr Qanun An Nahr, SW	This project helped construct a facility for housing the purification system. This project will ensure access to safe drinking water for the residents of the Municipality.
13	Capacity building	Tyre, SW	This QIP provided a differential GPS to UoTM, to enable the Regional Technical Office, which is supporting the UoTM to have access to a performant geo-spatial tool that will enable its officials to carry out their regular activity.
14	Social infrastructure	Marwahin, SW	The project sought to improve the quality of learning spaces and the educational environment at the Marwahin Public School by supporting the painting of its walls. Paints were also procured for painting three rooms at the Marwahin Municipal Office.
15	Social Infrastructure	Hallusiyat, SW	The project assisted the Municipality of Hallusiyat in completing the public park which it had funded and provided for in the town. The project supported the provision of facilities and infrastructure utilities for the public park.
16	Education	Jabel Amel Union, SE	The project equipped 10 kindergarten sections in public schools with equipment and items that will enable the schools to provide for better and improved learning spaces for its students.
17	Local Economy	Rachaya Al Foukhar, SE	The project supported the completion in the construction of a building that is used as a pottery workshop cum warehouse by members of the pottery cooperative.
18	Social infrastructure	Shaqra and Doubieh, SE	This project repaired the edges and surrounding pavements of a central square and also supported the provision of a central fountain.
19	Capacity building	Ayta Ash Sha'b, SW	This project equipped a child friendly space in the SDC of Ayta Ash Sha'b and provided training for SDC social workers and other caregivers on child protection and GBV.
20	Capacity building	Meiss ej Jebel, SE	This project provided tools and equipment to the Civil Defence Center in Meiss ej Jebel. With this equipment, the volunteers of the center will be better prepared and protected which will help them respond to emergencies better and serve the community in a more effective manner.
21	Water	Khiam, SE	This project helped in restoring and upgrading the existing water manhole' covers of the Dardara water source and irrigation system attached to it.
22	Health	Haddathah, SW	This project supported the rehabilitation of a building to be used as a public dispensary by the SDC of Bint Jubayl.
23	Local economy	Markaba, SE	This project renovated and equipped the agricultural centre so as to improve the production possibilities. The centre falls under the Lebanese Agriculture Ministry and its rehabilitation will benefit 70% of the farmers in the Marjayoun Caza, who are around 2000.
24	Water	Bint Jubayl, SW	This project is a part of a bigger project which aimed at providing material and water infrastructure work to connect water pipes over 7500 metres in Bint Jubayl.
25	Health	Bazuriyah, SW	This project rehabilitated Amel Association's medical Center in Bazuriyah, which provides medical care to Lebanese nationals as also to Syrian refugees. This medical center provides medical care to more than 1000 patients every month and is accredited by the Ministry of Public Health.

26	Women/capacity building	Tyre, SW	This QIP supported the conduct of workshop that included sessions on municipal legislation, Lebanese administration and role of women in municipal councils, delivered to 70 women selected from different backgrounds.
27	Environment/sanitation	Bafliyah, SW	This project provided a sewage network to one of the town's quarter, where approximately there are 50 households or 250 people reside. By establishing this network, there will be no more individual sewage pits and the purity of the underground fresh water will be maintained.
28	Water	Sil'a, SW	This project helped install a water purification system in the town of Sil'a, to enable residents to have unhindered access to clean drinking water.
